Film 1 is an introductory filmmaking course. Students will learn basic filmmaking skills: storytelling, scripting, iPad camera use, and iPad video editing skills. Students will produce several short films.

Classroom Expectations (Rules)

BE RESPONSIBLE: be on time and prepared for class, do your best, be active in completing all assignments, follow school and classroom expectations and policies, etc.

COVID Policies

This year will be very different than normal. During the COVID pandemic, you will be required to stay home when you are sick; wear a face covering while in the classroom; sanitize your hands when entering the classroom, changing activities in class, and leaving the classroom; have an assigned seat and work only with your table group; sanitize shared equipment after use; and sanitize your table, chair, and high-touch areas before you leave class. These policies are in place to keep us all safe and healthy. These policies may change as the pandemic situation changes.

Rewards for Good Choices

Your good choices will be rewarded with Gold Tokens and Cool 2 Care Cards. Gold Tokens allow you to spin the wheel to win a prize. Cool 2 Care Cards can be put in for prize drawings or be traded for a candy bar. Hard work and good behavior can also lead to the opportunity to learn more advanced filmmaking technologies and techniques.

Consequences for Bad Choices

- 3: Hallway conference and/or detention, call home
- 4: Referral to office for disciplinary action*

Class Technology

You will need your charged iPad in class every day. The main website for our class will be Canvas; parents/guardians, I highly recommend that you become an observer on your student's Canvas. SIS is where you can find official school grades and attendance information. We will integrate other technology tools throughout the semester.

Supplies and Fees

Please bring your charged iPad, power cord, headphones or earbuds, and a pen or pencil to class. We will use student iPads to capture video and audio. You are welcome to bring your own camera and audio equipment; take care of your equipment and keep it safe because the school and teacher are not liable for damage to or loss of personal equipment. Students may be required to pay for damage to or loss of school equipment caused by negligent behavior. Class fees will be used to purchase or replace filmmaking equipment.

General Policies

No food, drinks (except water bottles), or gum are allowed in class. Cell phones and other personal items will be silenced and put away; personal items that become a nuisance will be confiscated without a warning. Any evidence of plagiarism or cheating will result in the assignment being redone in detention, parent notification, and possible referral to the school administration. School and district rules will be enforced.

Attendance

In Person: You are expected to attend school when you are healthy and able. You are expected to arrive on time and be prepared for class. If you are absent, you are expected to log in to Canvas and make up what you missed before you return. If you come to class unprepared or missing assignments, you may not be able to participate in class activities.

Distance Learning: In the event that we are moved to distance learning, you will be expected to log in to Canvas and complete assignments each week. We may use Teams to have some live whole-class meetings, and you may be required to meet with the teacher individually on a Teams call.

Assignments and Homework

You will have assignments in class every day. Homework will be to finish any assignments you didn't finish in class, so you may need to work on assignments outside of class time. Most assignments will not be penalized for late submission; video submission assignments will be penalized 10% for late submission.

Grades

Your academic grade will be based on your assignments and projects. Your citizenship grade will be based on your behavior and work ethic in class. Grades will be calculated using the following scales, categories, and expectations. Grades are updated in Canvas daily and in SIS weekly (by Monday morning).
