As we all settle in to the new school year and its daily routines, we are exceptionally concerned with the safety behaviors of our students, and are looking for your help.

To facilitate safe travel to and from school, the Heber City has invested more than \$14,000 per year in crossing guards at the corner of **980 South and South Mill Road**.

Unfortunately, some students are trying to cross South Mill Road at **600 South**, where **no** crossing guards have been posted. As a result, we have had reports of **near crashes** as students try to cross the road on their bikes.

That is why we need you to educate your child(ren), and **insist** they **ONLY** cross South Mill Road at the designated spot: **South Mill Road and 980 South**.
