Community: Wasatch County is the fastest growing county in Utah, with a strong history in agriculture and a growing year-round resort community. Wasatch high school is the only high school in the district, serving over 2,450 students in grades 9-12.

Curriculum:

We are a comprehensive four-year public high school utilizing a block schedule with 8 classes total. Grades are reported quarterly, with a traditional unweighted GPA of 0-4.0 **The average composite ACT score is a 21.**

Advanced Placement Courses:

English language, English literature, Spanish language, studio art, music theory, chemistry, physics 1, human geography, world history, U.S. history, calculus AB, statistics, and U.S. government.

463 tests were given last year, with an 88% pass rate at WHS

Honors Options: math 1, 2, and 3, English 9 and 10, biology, physics, chemistry, and Spanish for native speakers 1, 2, and 3.

We offer over 40 concurrent enrollment college credit courses. **5,231 concurrent credits were earned last year.**

We also offer state skill certification in medical, nursing, and dental assisting.

We have a dual immersion Spanish language program with 111 students enrolled, many earning the seal of biliteracy..
