

HOW TO OPT IN for Text Messaging

Dear Parents and Guardians

It is our districts goal to have all parents receive information using the School Messaging System (SMS). This system allows us to share important information efficiently and fast. It is an easy 2 step process first send a text to opt in, second download the app and choose which types of messages you'd like to receive by text email or phone calls.

To "OPT IN" Text messaging

Send a text to 67587 with the comment "Yes"

You will receive a verification message:

"Wasatch County SD messages. Reply Y to subscribe or STOP to cancel. Msg&data rates may apply. Msg freq varies. Visit schoolmessenger.com/txt for info"

After opting in you will receive texts for emergencies, drills, lock downs, etc.

To avoid charges, check with your wireless carrier for information about your mobile service plan and any possible charges related to text messaging. Our organization does not reimburse for any charges associated with sending or receiving text messages. You can stop messages anytime by sending the message "STOP".

To Download the app to your smart phone or device

On your smartphone or device go to- go.schoolmessenger.com

After downloading- log in or sign up then log in

Once logged in, click on the menu bars (upper left) and select preferences. Here you can choose how you would like to receive messages for Emergency, Attendance, General information, Surveys, Food Services, and Text.

If the phone number that populates in the app is NOT the one at which you would like to receive texts (or if it is your land line), please contact Kirsta Albert, Communications Director, at 435-654-6886 (w), 435-640-1638 (c) or K.Albert@Wasatch.edu, and let her know which phone number(s) you would prefer.
