Families First Stimulus Package

- Families who use ITIN's will NOT qualify for the stimulus checks nor will their children even if they are LPRs or US citizens
- The latest guidance they have is that, because many DACA recipients have Social Security Numbers and file tax returns, IRS will view them as eligible for the rebates and automatically issue them. DACA recipients who do not file tax returns or have an SSN may not be eligible.
- All people qualify for testing regardless of health insurance status (people testing should not be asking about immigration status)

 - One person has to have a legal immigrant status (can be the child)
