BEFORE SCHOOL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attend school every day. Arrive on time. Come ready to learn. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure that my child gets good food, adequate clothing, rest and shelter. Ensure that my child attends school daily and arrives on time. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create a safe, inviting, learning atmosphere.
DURING SCHOOL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be prepared for school with completed assignments. Pay attention to my teacher and ask questions when I need help. Work cooperatively with my classmates. Follow directions and all school rules by being safe, kind and responsible. Model respectful behavior to children and adults. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Know what my child is expected to learn. Help my child achieve mastery of grade level core subjects. Contact my child's teacher when he/she does not understand assignments or needs special help. Consistently support school rules by being safe, kind and responsible. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide quality instruction and promote excellence with effective learning activities. Hold high expectations for all students. Offer assistance as needed to accommodate students' learning needs. Help students find appropriate books to read. Model respectful behavior to children and adults by being safe, kind and responsible. Communicate frequently about student progress, especially positive aspects. Make my classroom and myself accessible to parents, encouraging them to visit the school with opportunities to volunteer.
AFTER SCHOOL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete my homework assignments neatly and on time. Ask for help on homework when needed. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check my child's backpack daily. Provide a quiet place for my child to complete homework. Talk with my child to see if he/she understands assignments and homework. Sign my child's homework if needed. Offer my child encouragement and support. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide clear directions for homework. Inform parents of how and when I may be contacted and provide assistance. Conduct conferences that provide details about student progress and help students set meaningful goals.
ALWAYS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask my family to read to me or with me for at least 20 minutes each day. Attend conferences so my teacher can help me set goals. Work hard to achieve my conference goals. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read aloud with my child each day and allow my child to see me reading regularly. Communicate with my child's teacher on a regular basis and attend all conferences. Assist with school projects at school or home. Model respectful behavior to children and adults by being safe, kind and responsible. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share strategies that can be used to address goals at home. Participate in professional development that will continually improve my teaching. Principal will foster opportunities to participate in decision making.
